### **Updated recommendations include:**

#### **Recommendation**

Psychological, behavioral, and depression screening ( $\geq 11$  years)

#### **Immunizations**

##### Influenza:

For first immunization of children  $\leq 8$  years, give 2 doses one month apart. Age  $\geq 9$ , and all children with 2 prior doses, give 1 dose annually.

##### Human Papilloma Virus (HPV):

Give 2-dose series if started at 9-14 years. Give 3-dose series for ages 15-26, or if immunocompromised.
